## Not your mother's ivory tower

#### National Library of Israel:

3 descriptive cataloguing departments

- Hebrew: 6.5 FTE, ~2000 titles/month
- Arabic: 4.2 FTE, ~700 titles/month
- Foreign Languages: 6.6 FTE, ~1700 titles/month

#### Mazal – the Israel National Authority File

- ~1.9 million name authority records
- multiscript (Arabic, Cyrillic, Hebrew, Latin)
