## General

We agree with the changes proposed, with the following comments and suggestions.

## Change #1

### 1.7.7 Letters, Numerals or Words Intended to be Read More than Once

Insert a comma after "Numerals"

Proposed text

If one or more letters, numerals or words ~~a letter or word~~ appears only once but the design of the source of information makes it clear that they are ~~it is~~ intended to be read more than once, repeat the letters, numerals or words.

We suggest the following slightly simpler version.

"If any letter, numeral, or word appears only once, but the design of the source of information makes it clear that it is intended to be read more than once, repeat the letter, numeral, or word."
