RSC Assessment Group

- Formed as an outcome of the RSC April 2021 meeting
- Addresses issues beyond routine editorial decisions, which are often in the territory of broader questions and principles
- Membership
 - RSC Secretary, RSC regional representatives
- Responsibilities of the group
 - Analyzes the issue and then...
 - Refers it for action to an appropriate person or group (to create a proposal, fast track, etc.), or
 - Determines that the change cannot be accommodated in base RDA

Resource Description & Access

Assessing more issues ...

- Person: <u>place of residence</u> remove scope note "A place where a person has worked or studied is included".
- Ongoing discussion on principle of "uniformity". The objective of "internationalization" points to a wider issue:

Given the flexibility of the guidance and recording methods, the metadata provided by different agents will not necessarily be identical, but as well-formed data it will be understood by any agent when shared. The emphasis is on data harmonization rather than strict compatibility.



Community Resources Moving English language content to new location in Toolkit

- Sept. 2020: Abbreviations, capitalization, initial articles, etc.
- April 2021: Legacy Anglo-American instructions for pseudo-elements (legal, musical, religious works, and official communications)

Community resources

This area of RDA toolkit holds content that conforms to the RDA standard but is specific to language or specialist communities rather than international in scope.

Community resources is subarranged into two areas:

- Community refinements → provides additional guidance and instructions for existing RDA elements that are applicable to specific communities
- Community vocabularies 1 provides controlled terms for use as values of specific RDA elements using specialized community-based vocabularies or language-based vocabularies.

Community refinements

Community refinements provide more granular community-based refinements of RDA instructions to support string encoding schemes, transcription rules, and other string processing functions.

The refinements are not maintained as part of RDA, but are pertinent to **RDA toolkit** user communities.

Some refinements are legacy instructions that may have been used in RDA metadata statements in the past. Some are instructions that pertain to the formulation of a specific string encoding scheme.

Manifestation refinements

These refinements contain instructions for specific RDA elements for particular communities.

The refinements are not maintained as part of RDA, but are pertinent to RDA toolkit user communities.

Some refinements are instructions that pertain to the formulation of a specific string encoding scheme.

- authorized access point for manifestation: legacy Anglo-American instructions → I
- distribution statement: legacy Anglo-American instructions 3
- edition statement: legacy Anglo-American instructions → I
- manufacture statement: legacy Anglo-American instructions 1
- production statement: legacy Anglo-American instructions → I
- publication statement: legacy Anglo-American instructions 3
- <u>series statement:</u> legacy Anglo-American instructions 1



<u>Community Resources – Further Refinements</u> <u>and Vocabularies</u>

- Normalizing data found in manifestations (capitalization, etc.)
- Access point construction (string encoding schemes)
- Community vocabularies (e.g., Gender)
- Extensions to carrier and content type (see the "how-to" guidance for making these)
- Subtypes of RDA entities and elements (including new "shortcut" relationship elements)
- Community application profiles
- Suggested friendly labels for elements

Community Resources has content – Now What?

- Hand off "ownership" from RSC to other groups
 - For English: some Anglo-American community (or group of communities)
 - NARDAC + ORDAC + British Library, etc.? [not yet settled]
 - For Finnish:
 - Ready to translate the English text of Community Resources for their purposes
- Communities implementing Community Resources need to
 - Figure out how this part of RDA Toolkit works for them in concert with base RDA, policy statements, application profiles, etc.
 - Commit to regular review and revision
 - Ensure the content remains compatible with RDA
 - Update the CMS (Content Management System), or provide content for someone else to add
